International Coastal Cleanup 2011 had 26 registered events in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia Counties. Volunteers removed 77,558 pounds of trash and debris from local waterways. International Coastal Cleanup is one of the largest international volunteer events in the world. The cleanup gives citizens the opportunity to clean up their local waterways and to be a part of a large organized event.

Since 2005, Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful has been organizing and empowering citizens to cleanup throughout the Delaware Estuary, making a difference in their communities and coastal environment. Together with support from the Coastal Zone Resource Program and other community partners, over 3,000 concerned citizens have removed 257,878 pounds of trash from the Delaware Estuary and other coastal communities.
