Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful is proud to be the Pennsylvania statewide coordinator for the International Coastal Cleanup, the world's largest volunteer effort to improve the health of the world's oceans and local waterways. The International Coastal Cleanup is one of the largest international volunteer events. The Cleanup gives citizens around the world the opportunity to clean up their local waterways and to be a part of a larger movement.

From September through October, Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful worked together with local groups and organizations to coordinate 123 events throughout the state. Nearly 8,000 volunteers from 48 counties across Pennsylvania canvassed their communities to remove over 714,000 pounds of trash and debris from Pennsylvania's waterways and coastal regions during the 2012 International Coastal Cleanup event.

Together, Pennsylvanians made a sea of change in the health of the states waterways!
