Keep Norristown Beautiful Wins the Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful 2018 Great American Cleanup of PA Video Contest

(July 3, 2018) – The winning entry of the annual Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful Great American Cleanup of PA video contest, sponsored by the PA Waste Industry Association and the Department of Environmental Protection, was submitted by <u>Keep Norristown Beautiful</u>. Keep Norristown Beautiful received a \$200 cash prize for their video showing residents of all ages how they keep Pennsylvania beautiful by cleaning residential neighborhoods and public spaces in Norristown, Montgomery County, including 20 acres of park. The cleanup resulted in the removal and proper disposal of 132 bags of trash and involved over 100 volunteers! Keep Norristown Beautiful is the newest Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful Affiliate.

Two runners up received a cash prize of \$100 each and Include <u>Build a Better New Cumberland</u> in Cumberland County, whose residents cleaned up the downtown area, library grounds and a borough park and <u>Lancaster</u> <u>Mennonite School – Hershey Campus</u> in Dauphin County, whose students performed a litter cleanup, weeded, mulched and planted flowers in Shank Park, Derry Township. The school formally adopted Shank Park through the Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful adoption program in 2016.
