- Clean up litter when you see it.




Mandrand Mand





### Make a Birdfeeder From a Plastic Bottle

#### What You Need:

- One large plastic drink bottle with cap
- 3 or 4 wooden dowels (or pencils) each 3/16" wide and about 8" long
- Nail or other sharp object for punching holes in the bottle
- String or wire 16"-18" long





### Here's What To Do:

1. Wash the bottle and remove the label.

- 2. To make a perch, use a nail to punch 2 holes in the bottle, opposite each other. Insert a dowel or pencil so that it passes through one hole, through the bottle, and out the other side. Make 3 or 4 such perches alternating the positions so that all sides of the bottle are used.
- 3. Now you're ready to poke the feeding holes. With the bottle's neck facing away from you, use a nail to poke a small hole about 2" above each perch. Keep in mind that the seeds will fall out if the holes are too big.
- 4.Use the nail to poke a hole from one side of the bottle's neck to the other.
- 5. Thread the string of wire through the holes in the bottle's neck and tie or twist them together at the ends. This will be your hanger.
- 6. Remove the cap and fill the feeder with sunflower seeds or mixed seed. Screw the cap back on and hang the feeder from a branch or hook.






# How long will litter last?





### See For Yourself


Find out which items are biodegradable and which are not by doing this simple test.



- 1. Fill the containers with soil and dampen with water.
- 2. Bury each piece of common litter in its own container and label.
- 3. Leave the containers in a cool, damp place for 2-4 weeks.
- 4. Dig up the pieces of litter and see if they have rotted or changed at all.

### How It Works:

The natural garbage will start to decompose or may rot away altogether because it is biodegradable. The man-made garbage will take longer to decompose or will not change at all. Luckily, we can recycle much of our non-biodegradable garbage so that it can be used again.






### Draw a picture of where you live. Is there litter near your home?






Draw a line on each item to show if it should go in the **recycling** bin, **trash** can or **compost** bin.




# Litter, litter everywhere; You're the one who has to care.
