(April 19, 2024) In celebration of Earth Day, Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful, whose vision is a clean and beautiful Pennsylvania, encourages residents to join the 2024 Pick Up Pennsylvania initiative. During this time, trash collected at registered events can be taken to participating landfills, with prior approval.
