

KPB Litter Summit Proposed Walking Tour

The tour will start in front of the Hilton Hotel 100 Adams Ave, and cover about 9 blocks. Each stop will feature aspects of Scranton Tomorrow's Safe, Clean, Green, and Design program. All of which is easily relatable and can be in part used in other locations.

- 1. The planter project: we will talk about the history of the 140 sidewalk planters, the success and failures, plant selection and care, budget, and volunteers
- 2. The Lackawanna County Gateway Building: we will look at the importance of improving city gateways, urban landscaping, working with specific volunteers, the community partners, and the impact of this project
- 3. Courthouse Square: an overview of the pollinator gardens, and an evaluation of the grounds.
- 4. The Pocket Park: this was a contaminated site which adds complications to developing green space. We will go over the history of the project and what it took to bring the project to its present state
- 5. The Bee Mural: This is an example of using public art to foster environmental stewardship. We will talk about adding landscaping to a small space.
