KPB Litter Summit Proposed Walking Tour

The tour will start in front of the Hilton Hotel 100 Adams Ave, and cover about 9 blocks. Each stop will feature aspects of Scranton Tomorrow's Safe, Clean, Green, and Design program. All of which is easily relatable and can be in part used in other locations.

1. The planter project: we will talk about the history of the 140 sidewalk planters, the success and failures, plant selection and care, budget, and volunteers
2. The Lackawanna County Gateway Building: we will look at the importance of improving city gateways, urban landscaping, working with specific volunteers, the community partners, and the impact of this project
3. Courthouse Square: an overview of the pollinator gardens, and an evaluation of the grounds.
4. The Pocket Park: this was a contaminated site which adds complications to developing green space. We will go over the history of the project and what it took to bring the project to its present state
5. The Bee Mural: This is an example of using public art to foster environmental stewardship. We will talk about adding landscaping to a small space.
