AMERICA250PA AND KEEP PENNSYLVANIA BEAUTIFUL AWARD OVER \$30,000 FOR COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT GRANTS

May 5, 2025 – The Pennsylvania Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial (America250PA), in partnership with Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful, EQT Corporation and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, today announced the ten recipients of its 2025 National Pennsylvania Day Mini Grants. Grants totaling over \$30,000 were awarded in support of projects that improve the community and engage volunteers. Projects could include park and cemetery improvements, revitalization efforts, plantings, painting of community assets, river sweeps, graffiti abatement and murals.

Grants up to \$4,000 were available to existing America250PA partners.
