

POCONO 3C









Pocono Community Caring Company (Pocono 3C) is a collaboration of RHD Street2Feet, The Waste Authority and the Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau. Announced in June of 2019, the program is designed to give persons who are homeless, or in danger of becoming homeless, a job and case work, to get back on their feet. These individuals often face significant barriers to employment, such as lacking an ID or address, not having a bank account, or having a minor criminal record.

Pocono 3C provides no-barrier employment with same-day pay to help overcome these challenges. Pocono 3C provides consistent work to these individuals for three days a week cleaning up litter along Monroe County, PA roadways.

Compensation includes monetary gift cards at the end of each shift to buy essential items such as food, clothing and medications. These participants also receive work experience as well as job references for future employment opportunities. In addition to employment, participants receive lunch on workdays and access to ongoing case management.

The Waste Authority provides transportation to and from each work location and supervises the employees by using a Waste Authority Police Officer. The Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau funds the programs and publicizes all the amazing work they do while Street2Feet chooses the employees and becomes the employee's direct employer.

To date, **22 individuals** have been able to obtain housing and employment through the help of Pocono 3C including **Elisha Spencer**. Elisha is employed at The Waste Authority after having worked his way through the program.



Spencer joined representatives from the three organizations, dignitaries, and Pocono 3C members at the Military Road Recycling Facility, operated by The Waste Authority, to mark six years of Pocono 3C.



"It feels pretty good. I remember where I came from, and no one would give me a chance. But, you know, the people at 3C and people at the Municipal Waste Authority, they gave me a chance," said Spencer.

"And like I said, I'm not going to fail because that's just my ethic. I can't, I can't fail. Yeah. You know, and they gave me an opportunity to try it and I won't let them down. That's, that's just how it has to be. Because no one else would give me a chance. And they were the only people that did. And I'm very grateful."
